In scattered pockets from the Carolinas to the frontier in Texas, these dissenters, or "brush men," often died at the hands of their own neighbors as a result of their belief in the Union or an unwillingness to preserve the slaveholding Confederacy. Four more chapters follow, each detailing the horror and hysteria that characterized post-Civil War Texas.
