In trying to redress this huge imbalance, I have focused mainly on male painters. As a retired psychiatrist, I could write about these artists, and the women who were their intimate partners, without discussing their psychopathology. In writing about this I have struggled to avoid jargon and to ensure readability. The main focus is on the relationship between psychopathology and creativity, with some comments about the effects of psychiatric treatment on the creative process. The bias of the book is feminist, but my voice here is not strident. I have tried to comment
